# FEBRUARY

#### Light Night

(VARIOUS VENUES) As darkness descends, stunning light installations and special events bring the city centre to life for afterdark adventures.

## APRIL

#### The Magnificent Spiegeltent

(OLD MARKET SQUARE) Experience several weeks of music, circus, cabaret, theatre, comedy and burlesque inside a beautiful, century-old travelling dance hall.

### MAY

#### Dot to Dot Festival

(VARIOUS VENUES) A jam-packed one-day festival of experimental music, hot new talent and established acts from all over the globe.

### JUNE

#### **Detonate Festival**

(COLWICK COUNTRY PARK) Party in the idyllic surroundings of Colwick Country Park to a soundtrack of the best underground and electronic music.

### Nottingham Puppet Festival

(VARIOUS VENUES)

Local, national and international puppet artists bring their talents to the city, with a medley of free street theatre, shows, workshops and music and plenty more spectacular sights and sounds taking place.

#### Splendour

(WOLLATON HALL AND DEER PARK) Nottingham's favourite family festival where you can watch a fantastic line up of new artists and international superstars in the beautiful backdrop of Wollaton Park.

#### Nottingham Beach

(OLD MARKET SQUARE)

Enjoy a trip to the seaside with sand, sea and a range of thrilling rides, traditional sideshows and great food & drink for the whole family.

#### Nottingham Riverside Festival

(VICTORIA EMBANKMENT)

The East Midlands' biggest free festival on the banks of the River Trent, with live music, craft stalls, fairground rides, street entertainment, dragon boat racing and a Saturday night fireworks display.

#### Outdoor Cinema & Theatre

(VARIOUS HERITAGE ATTRACTIONS) Settle down for a relaxing afternoon or evening under the stars watching a variety of outdoor film and theatre performances at some of Nottingham's best-loved heritage attractions.

#### Nottinghamshire Pride

(NOTTINGHAM CITY CENTRE) Watch Nottingham's city streets come to life with a colourful parade, live music, and inspiring speeches and performances.

# AUGUST

#### Robin Hood Festival

(SHERWOOD FOREST)

Enjoy seven days of live re-enactments, song, dance, storytelling, sword-fighting, archery and adventures with the outlaws, along with lots of wonderful nature to discover in the forest too.

#### Nottingham Carnival

(VICTORIA EMBANKMENT) Watch the city's liveliest parade in a celebration of Nottingham's Caribbean heritage while enjoying great food, live music and the energetic atmosphere.



## SEPTEMBER

#### Festival of Food & Drink

(CLUMBER PARK)

Join some of the UK's best culinary creators as they congregate to offer mouth-watering fare, with celebrity chefs, a cookery school, live music, stalls and children's activities.

#### Ikano Bank Robin Hood Half Marathon

(VICTORIA EMBANKMENT) Join thousands of runners for the Half Marathon, Mini Marathon, Mile Challenge and Corporate Challenge.

### OCTOBER

#### **Robin Hood Beer and Cider Festival**

#### Goose Fair

(VARIOUS VENUES)
